### **"Lisa's Guide for Writers"**

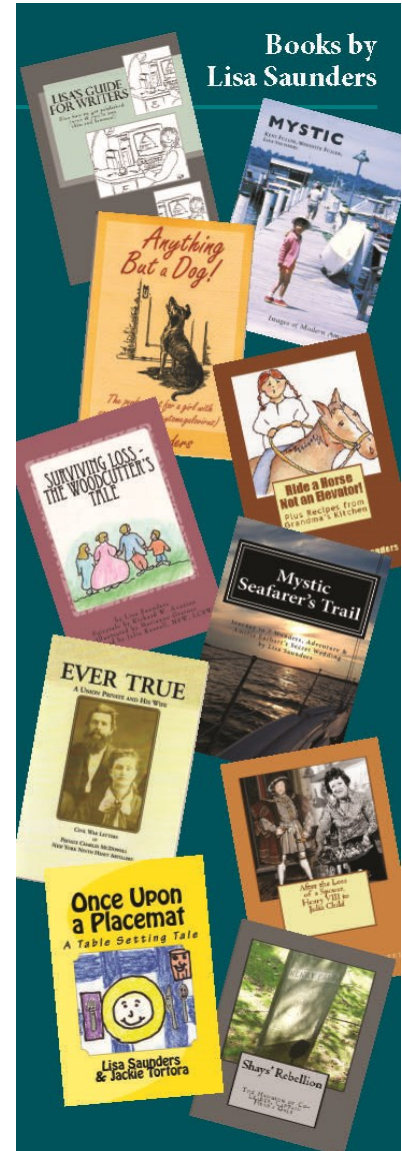
Non-fiction—Includes writing exercises and how to get published, even if you're not thin and famous!
