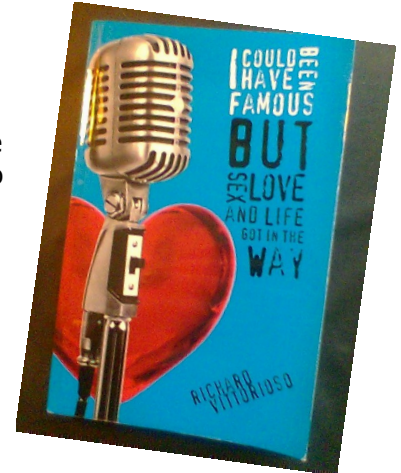
"I Could Have Been Famous But Sex, Love and Life Got In The Way" By Richard Vittorioso

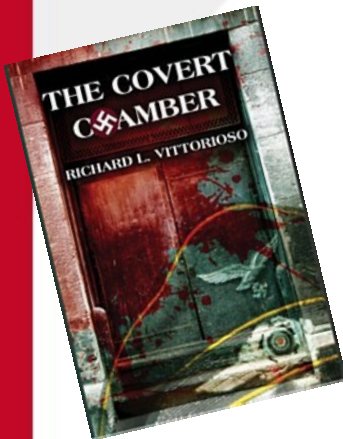
